### **The Visiting Nurse Association of South Central Connecticut Offers Seasonal Flu Clinic to the Public**

New Haven, CT (November 4, 2009) – The Visiting Nurse Association of South Central Connecticut (VNA/SCC) will be offering a seasonal flu clinic to the public on Monday, Nov. 9 from 1-3pm at its headquarters located at One Long Wharf Drive, Fifth Floor, in New Haven.

“We were fortunate that we are able to offer a public flu clinic. Thanks to the help of Attorney General Richard Blumenthal and our national association, The Visiting Nurse Association of America, we received all the vaccines that we ordered,” John R. Quinn, President & CEO of VNA Health Systems said. “As a non-profit, our mission is to manage our resources wisely so that the community can receive the maximum benefit, and in this case we were able to keep our commitment to all of our scheduled clinics and now have some extra vaccines available to offer to the public.”

The VNA/SCC has only 150 doses of the seasonal flu vaccine available. The vaccine is appropriate for individuals aged nine and older. Individuals **MUST** call and make an appointment to receive the vaccine. Walk-ins cannot be accommodated. **To make an appointment please call the VNA/SCC at 203.641.3227 from 9am-Noon on Thurs., Nov. 5 and Fri., Nov. 6.**

The following insurances are accepted: Medicare, Connecticare, HealthNet, and Anthem Blue Cross & Blue Shield. The cost of the vaccine for those who do not have one of the previously mentioned insurances is \$30.
